IEEPO Action Workshops: Ready, set, ACTION ...towards humanising healthcare!

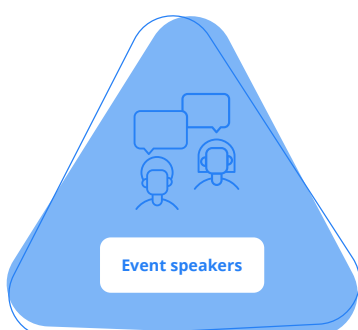
Here you'll be split into small groups and tasked to co-create an action plan to address a pre-selected challenge. At registration you can choose from the following challenges:
